GREAT IDEAS FOR Leftover Turkey

If you've had enough of hot and cold turkey sandwiches, these ideas will help you use up the remainder of your leftover turkey.

Add some turkey to your favorite salad. You can also add in some other seasonal flavors to liven things up. Try cubed turkey with chopped apple, celery, grapes, and nuts. Toss with poppy-seed dressing and serve on fresh spinach leaves. Top with a few mandarin oranges and some more nuts.

Make barbecue sandwiches by heating shredded turkey in some barbecue sauce and serving on crusty rolls. Top with sliced red onion, a few pickle slices, and a spoonful of coleslaw to complete your meal.

Turkey is a great addition to your favorite chili recipe. Since your turkey is already cooked, be sure to add it at the last minute to prevent it from becoming dry and overcooked.

If you don't have enough time to make a classic turkey soup from your leftovers, simply stir some chopped turkey meat into your favorite prepared soup.

Have some turkey for breakfast. Use up your leftover vegetables and turkey in an omelet or scrambled eggs. Add some cheese to complete your dish.

Turkey tacos can be easily made by combining leftover turkey meat and taco seasoning. Spoon into a warmed taco shell, and top with lettuce, chopped tomato, cheese, salsa, and avocado.

4 tips for a SAFE Thanksgiving Meal

- 1 Buy your foods from a reliable source. All perishables should be promptly and properly refrigerated.
- 2 Clean your hands and all surfaces that have been in contact with raw meat or eggs before touching anything else. This includes cutting boards, knives, utensils, and countertops.
- 3 Your turkey should not be stuffed until right before entering the oven, and your oven temperature should be set to no lower than 325 degrees.
- 4 Promptly refrigerate all leftovers in tightly covered containers. If food has been left out longer than two hours, it should be discarded. Refrigerated stuffing should be eaten within two days; refrigerated turkey should be consumed within three to four days.

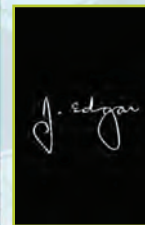
Stan Robinson's Most Anticipated MOVIES
