


Historical & Celebrity January Birthdays & Fun Facts

'The Theory of Everything' is my best of 2014!

A truly remarkable performance by Eddie Redmayne in the title role who presents the physicality of healthy as young Stephen Hawking to an old man with (ALS), or Lou Gehrig's Disease, who goes on to become one of the greatest theoretical physicist of the modern era.

And here are some of my other top films of 2014!

'Belle' Inspired by a true story, half Black and raised by her aristocratic great-uncle Lord Mansfield (Tom Wilkinson) and his wife (Emily Watson), shapes Lord Mansfield's role as Lord Chief Justice to end slavery in England with the Slave Trade Act of 1807.

'Boyhood' Filmed over 12 years with the same cast, director Richard Linklater groundbreaking story through the eyes of a child named Mason (Ellar Coltrane), who literally grows up on screen before our eyes is impressive filmmaking!

'Gone Girl' Director David Fincher's well paced drama of a man's wife's disappearance as the focus of an intense media circus spotlight turns on him when it's suspected that he may not be innocent, grabs hold to the very last sequence and what a twist for the ending to the film!

'Into The Woods' A delightful mix of song, performances, and fantasy escape, as a witch conspires to teach important lessons to various characters of popular children's stories including Little Red Riding Hood, Cinderella, Jack and the Beanstalk, and Rapunzel.

'The Judge' Robert Duvall and Robert Downey Jr. are exceptional as the father and son in a story of a big city lawyer who returns to his childhood home where his father, the town's judge, is suspected of murder.

'St. Vincent' Writer/director Theodore Melfi's film of a young boy whose parents have just divorced and finds an unlikely friend and mentor in the misanthropic, bawdy, hedonistic war veteran who lives next door, is a heartwarming story with lessons for the young and the old!
